THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF ORANGE I KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. H. Stark, of the County of Orange, and State of Texas, being in good health, of sound and disposing mind and memory, and above the age of twenty-one years, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST.

I direct that all my just debts shall be paid.

SECOND.

It is my will and desire that all of the property, both real and personal, I may die seized and possessed of, after the payment of all of my just debts, together with all the expenses incident to the probating of this will, shall pass to and vest in fee simple in my adored wife, Miriam M. Lutchter Stark, equally, share and share alike, the remainder of all the property I may now own, real, personal or mixed and wherever located or situated, or be interested in at the time of my death, and to take the same in fee simple.

THIRD.

I authorize, empower and instruct my executor, hereinafter named, to continue the monthly payment of those certain sums of money to my two sisters and sister-in-law so long as they shall live, as follows:

Mrs. Mary V. Kelly, my sister, one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) dollars per month;

Mrs. E. R. Ford, my sister, twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars per month; and
Mrs. Serena Stark, wife of my deceased brother Jerry Stark, thirty (\$30.00) dollars per month;

and that my said executor make provision for the timely payment of these said bequests and legacies unto the said Mrs. Mary V. Kelly, Mrs. E. R. Ford and Mrs. Serena Stark, in the respective sums hereinabove mentioned.

FOURTH.

I hereby constitute and appoint my son, H. J. Lutchter Stark, independent executor of this, my last will and testament, and direct that no bond or security be required of him as executor.

FIFTH.

It is my will that no other action shall be had in the county court in the administration of my estate than to prove and record this will and to return an inventory and appraisement of my estate and all claims.


